


## St Mary's Church of England Primary School

### **Special Educational Needs Questionnaire Responses: December 2017**

- 1. I am aware of how the school provides for pupils with SEND at St. Mary's.
- 2. I have had opportunities to discuss my child's needs with their teacher.
- 3. Issues raised about SEND including my child's needs are dealt with efficiently.
- 4. I am informed about when outside agencies are involved e.g. if a referral is made and advice given.
- 5. I feel that school staff have given me suggestions of ways to support my child at home.
- 6. My child's SEND plan includes appropriate targets for my child.
- 7. I feel that the school values my contribution towards provision for my child.
- 8. My child feels safe and happy at St. Mary's.
- 9. My child feels they have someone to talk to at school if needed.
- 10. I am able to approach staff about any concerns that I have regarding my child.
- 11. The SEN sections on the school website are a useful resource providing further information and guidance.
- 12. The school's policy on SEND and Inclusion is clear and accessible to me as a parent.

### Summary of additional comments from parents:
